Royal Ranger Code

Alert

He is mentally, physically and spiritually alert.

Clean

He is clean in body, mind, and speech.

Honest

He does not lie, cheat or steal.

Courageous

He is brave in spite danger, criticism, or threats.

Loyal

He is faithful to his church, family, outpost, and friends.

Courteous

He is polite, kind, and thoughtful.

Obedient

He obeys his parents, leaders, and those in authority.

Spiritual

He prays, reads the bible and witnesses.

The Royal Ranger Code is not just something the boys are required to memorize, this is the way a Ranger should live his life.

Uniforms

There are certain items your son will need. These items are available from the Royal Ranger Outpost.



One of the more important parts of this program is the **uniform**.

Uniforms create pride in one's appearance and contribute to a sense of responsibility. They also attract attention from other boys. Surveys have shown that boys join youth groups because of the **uniforms**, more than any other reason. The uniform also gives boys a sense of belonging.





Also, since the boys receive badges for their accomplishments, **uniforms** encourage the boys to participate in the advancement part of the program.

Awards Vest

The **awards vest** is a supplemental uniform item which allows boys to display all of the awards, training patches, and event patches they have earned in their current age group.

PURPOSE OF THE ROYAL RANGER MINISTRY

- C. To keep boys in our churches

Our Aim

To instruct, challenge, and inspire our boys in the areas of Bible doctrine, Christian service, moral conduct, and basic beliefs of our church through interesting activities the boys enjoy.

Our Goals

1. *To instruct in Bible doctrine.* When a boy completes this program he should have a basic knowledge of what the Bible teaches.
2. *To challenge for Christian service.* When a boy completes this program he should be ready to take his place in the area of Christian service where God wishes him to be.
3. *To inspire a belief in the fundamental beliefs of our church.* When a boy completes this program he should be Christian in belief the remainder of his life.
4. *To satisfy the boy's basic need for activity.* A boy engaged in this program should have enough interesting activities to do to prevent him from being tempted to engage in unwholesome activities.

BEFORE THE MEETING

- Running in the Church is not permitted.
- Fighting and rough housing is not permitted.
- There are to be no toys brought in (bats, balls, etc.) unless asked for by the leader.
- Once arriving for Royal Rangers, you are to stay in the meeting room until you are assigned by a leader to another location.
- Proper respect is to be given to all Leaders at all times.

DURING THE MEETING

- Boys are to be attentive and allowed to speak only after raising their hands and being recognized by the Leader in charge or the person speaking.
- During recreation, while passing in the Church halls, there will be no talking allowed, in order not to disrupt any other classes in progress.
- Boys will give the person in charge their full attention.
- Defacing of any type of property will result in the removal from the Royal Ranger program.

AFTER THE MEETING

- The boys will be responsible for their own things and are to pick-up all books and papers that belong to them and bring them home.
- The boys will be dismissed to the care of their parents at the end of the meeting.

Meeting Times and Dues

- Our meetings are held ***each Wednesday evening.***
- They begin at ***6:30 PM sharp and end promptly at 8:00 PM.***

Please help us to make the most of the ninety minutes, by seeing that your son is present for the start of the meetings.

For the care and safety of your son, we also ask for your help, in making certain that ***your son is picked up at the meeting room at 8:00 PM sharp.***

- ***We require the boys to pay dues of .50 cents each week*** to help defray some of the costs involved for supplies.

If your son misses a meeting, he is still required to pay his dues.

*In order for a boy to go on a camp-out or outing he will be required to be caught-up with his dues.

Royal Rangers is a mentoring program for future men. We provide Christlike character formation and servant leadership development for boys and young men in a highly relational and fun environment. Our mission is to evangelize, equip, and empower the next generation of Christlike men and lifelong servant leaders.



Our Mentoring Process

The Royal Rangers program is built on the premise that learning should be fun and interactive. Learning in Royal Rangers therefore follows a "hear-see-do-teach" mentoring process where boys hear instruction on a topic, sees the skill demonstrated, and are given the opportunity to do it themselves. Then, as their skills improve, they are given the opportunity to teach others, further developing their own understanding of the material.

ROYAL RANGERS UNIFORM ITEMS MEASUREMENTS CONVERSION CHARTS

HOW TO MEASURE

Stand normally, arms at sides. Measure over underwear. Keep the tape measure snug, not tight. To make certain garments fit properly, please measure carefully as indicated above, and consult the measurement charts below. Charts represent actual garment measurements. If measurement falls between sizes, order the next larger size.

Collar: Measure around the base of the neck.

Chest: Measure under the arms and around the fullest part of the chest.

Sleeve: Have him hold up one arm chest high and touch his nose. Measure from the back base of neck, across shoulder, around bend of elbow to the wrist.

Length: Measure from high point of shoulder (where collar meets shoulder) to just below belt line.
